



St. Louis School-Business Partnership Business Educator Experiential Learning Award 2019 Scholarship Requirements

The St. Louis School-Business Partnership (STLSBP) has allocated up to \$1000 total for FY19 for educators and businesses of member school districts to apply for funds to support summer projects and experiential learning opportunities with local business and industry. **Monies should be used to support costs, transportation, and fees for participating in approved projects. Monies will be paid on a reimbursement basis, upon completion of the project or experience.**

Interested educators must complete the project application and return it along with the additional required information and documents electronically to [the scholarship committee](#) by **Monday, April 15, 2019**. The STLSBP Scholarship Committee will review all applications and determine recipients. Recipients will be announced at the May 2nd End of the Year Partnership Luncheon at Normandy High School.

Eligibility Requirements

- Must be a paid STSBP member.
- Must be participating in some type of approved professional development experience with a business or industry during the summer of 2019 (May/June/July/August).
- Attending PLTW Core Training is not an eligible project or experience.
- Awardee will be required to present project at the Annual Fall Kickoff Event.

Additional Scholarship Application Requirements

- Provide one (1) letter of support from district or building administrator.
- Detailed goals of project and how funding will support and enhance proposed experience.
- Description of how project will enhance or support student learning.

Approved Projects and Payment:

- Approval amount will be based on needs identified in application, and determined based on the number of applications submitted and accepted.
- Final project report. Upon completion teacher will submit a final report to the SLSBP Board which will facilitate the payment of the approved amount.

The mission of the St. Louis School-Business Partnership is to foster a dynamic collaboration between school, community and businesses.

Friday, February 22, 2019

Funding information, application, and timelines will be distributed at the STLSBP Annual Workshop on Friday, February 22, 2019, emailed to members on Friday, March 1, 2019 and available on the partnership web site stlsbp.org.

Monday, April 15, 2019

All applications, project description, and required documents must be received and postmarked by no later than 4:00pm Monday, April 15, 2019.

April 16 – April 27, 2019

STLSBP Scholarship Committee will review all scholarship applications, essays, and required documents and select two scholarship winners.

April 30, 2019

Scholarship winners and their schools will be notified.

April 30, 2019

All STLSBP members will be notified by email as to the school districts of the winning students.

May 2, 2019

Winners will be announced at the STLSBP End of the Year Luncheon.
